T-BALL: AGES 4-6


- Co-ed, ages 4-6
- Coaches will contact parents with practice times and game schedule
- Games will be held at the T-ball field in the northeast corner of the Baseball Park

MACHINE PITCH: BOYS & GIRLS GRADES 1ST-2ND

- Separate boys' & girls' leagues, 1st-2nd grade
- Coaches will contact parents with practice times and game schedule
- All games will be held in Blanding: Girls Monday's & Wednesday's, Boys Tuesday's & Thursday's

BASEBALL & SOFTBALL LEAGUE: GRADES 3RD-8TH

- Separate boys' baseball & girls' softball leagues
 - Boys: 3rd-4th, 5th-6th, 7th-8th
 - Girls: 3rd-4th & 5th-6th
- Coaches will contact parents with practice times and game schedule
- Games will be in Monticello, Moab, & Blanding. All home games will be held at the Baseball Park



EQUIPMENT & UNIFORMS

Coaches will be provided team equipment at coaches meeting. All uniforms will be distributed by the first game.

- T-Ball
 - City Provided: Team helmets, T's, bats, and balls
 - Team t-shirts will be provided, that each player may keep.
 - Each player is responsible to supply their own shoes and shorts/pants
- Machine Pitch, Baseball, & Softball Leagues
 - City Provided: Catcher's gear, bats, and balls
 - Team jerseys will be provided, that are RETURNED at the end of the season.
 - Team hat's will be provided that each player may keep.
 - Each player is responsible to supply their own shoes/cleats and white pants (the city does have a limited supply of used pants available). Pants can also be purchased at Pick-A-Stitch 587.2676

END-OF SEASON PLAY

- All participants in baseball & softball leagues (grades 3rd-8th) will play in a 1-day district tournament held at the end of June. Games will take place in Monticello, Moab, and Blanding.
- There will be All-Star options for boys in the Cal Ripken (12U) and Babe Ruth (13 & Up) Leagues, as well as the girls (10U, 12U, 14U, 16U). This will be an option as organized by parents & coaches, not the city—although the city will be covering tournament fees. There will be the option to send 1 team per age group. The teams will be selected and organized by coaches. As these leagues are age based (as of May 1st) and the city leagues are grade based; All-Star teams will not necessarily be the same as city league teams. There will be an additional cost of \$20/player to participate in the All-Star teams, this does not include travel to or accommodations during tournaments. Coaches will be able to provide additional information.
